

## SDG 12.2.1

NUK conducts ethical procurement in accordance with the procurement policy of the Executive Yuan.

### 1. Green procurement policy:

- (1) Implement environmentally-friendly green procurement matters in accordance with "Organization's Priority Procurement of Environmental Protection Products Measures" and "Institutional Green Procurement Performance Evaluation Methods 2023" formulated by the EPA in 2001.
- (2) The implementation rate of green procurement in 2022 was 99.44%. The annual green purchase amount was USD 448,353.

### 2. Priority procurement policy:

- (1) In accordance with Article 69, "People with Disabilities Rights Protection Act" and the "Regulation for Obligated Purchasing Units / Institutions to Purchase the Products and Services Provided by Disabled Welfare Institutions, Organizations or Sheltered Workshops", priority procurement matters is implemented.
- (2) The total amount of priority purchases in 2022 is USD 20,792, and the achievement rate is 5.66%, which is in line with the 5% stipulation in Article 3 of "Products Measures".
