Item 1: Promote the provision of free educational resources by Extension Education Center:

- The Ministry of Education: "University for Seniors" program is aimed at senior citizens over the age of 55. Through integration with the community, it is hoped that nearby senior citizens can return to school after retirement or taking a break from the workplace to achieve the lifelong learning philosophy of "live to learn, learn to live," and those who complete the course will be awarded a certificate of completion by the University. The courses are fully subsidized for those who meet the specific criteria, such as teenagers between the ages of 15-18 who are not enrolled in school and not employed, independent homemakers, middle-aged and elderly people, the unemployed over the age of 65, indigenous people, physically and mentally challenged people, the long-term unemployed, second-time-employed women, and middle- and low-income households. Item 2: Organize Special Senior High School Class

- The University actively links the industry and society, and has been promoting quality programs and scientific experimental classes in senior high schools for a long period of time. Since 2018, the University has developed tailor-made learning contents for senior high school freshmen and sophomores in "Petrochemical Industry Renda Special Class" and "International English Special Class". In 2022, "Petrochemical Class" offered 15 theoretical and practical courses covering the petrochemical industry, such as "Chemistry of Green Materials", and the corporation will provide scholarships for students with outstanding academic performance and preferential admissions opportunities. In addition, "English Class" incorporates SDGs into the syllabus and offers a series of 11 courses on international issues, global climate change, sustainable consumption, and English, establishing a new mode of cooperation between the university, the national education department, and the local industry.

Item 3: Environmental Education Course

- 1. The University and the Pingtung Forestry Management Office of the Forestry and Nature Conservation Agency jointly organized a prevention of invasive plants and awareness promotion activity through hands-on clearing competitions which was open to the University affiliated and unaffiliated personnel for free. The Forestry Management Office also prepared experiential activities such as dyeing eggs with plants and puzzles. More than 200 people, including faculty, staff, students, eco-guard volunteers, and residents and shopkeepers from the neighboring communities, participated in the event. In order to serve the teachers and students of primary and secondary schools in Kaohsiung and promote environmental education, six environmental education experiential courses were held during the week of September to November 2022, and were open to teachers and students of Kaohsiung high schools and elementary schools to participate for free. The courses included four sessions of "I am a Butterfly", which focuses on butterfly conservation and the habitat environment, and two sessions of "Campus Focus", which explored the dangers of economic insects and invasive species such as Kerria lacca, and participants were offered proof of their involvement of the activities.
