1. According to “NUK Library Regulations of Usage of Books”, unaffiliated persons are allowed to swap their valid ID card for temporary reading card to view the open-shelf collections, use the reading space, catalogue and personal computer with the Library approval. Item 3. MOOCs online teaching resources

1. NUK produces MOOCs online teaching resources and provides them for the public. The courses, including series courses on Thai, Vietnamese, Indonesian and Japanese, are on three major Taiwan MOOCs platforms. After completing the course requirements, there are 5 courses in Thai language module, 8 courses in Vietnamese language module, and 1 course in semiconductor microfilming module, a total of 14 courses will be provided free of charge, and students of other courses can also pay for a certificate of attendance for the course; if the courses are formal credit MOOCs, they can apply for credit when they are enrolled in the school. 50 MOOCs were offered in 2022, with a total of 47,505 visits.

Item 4. Asia Virtual Academy, Spring Forum Series, 2022

1. Teachers and students from partner schools can watch the live broadcast through YouTube, Facebook and other platforms, and there is zero-time lag in international exchanges.
